(Same venue as the 20th Aichi-Nagoya Asian Games 2026)

CHAMPIONSHIP INFORMATION

Venue

Kinjo-Futo Arena : 2-7, Kinjo-Futo, Minato-ku, Nagoya City, Aichi, Japan 455-0848

- 3 Singles Glass Courts and 1 Doubles Glass Court will be used

*It takes 24 minutes from 'Nagoya Station' by train. [AONAMI LINE] to 'Kinjo-Futo Station'

Events

1. Men's Singles / 24 Draw
2. Women's Singles / 24 Draw
3. Mixed Doubles / 16 Draw

ENTRY REGULATIONS:

Each ASF registered Member Nation may enter players/pairs in accordance with the following regulations. Double entry in Singles and Mixed Doubles is not permitted.

1. **Men's Singles** – Maximum of 2 players per country
2. **Women's Singles** – Maximum of 2 players per country
3. **Mixed Doubles** – Maximum of 2 pairs per country

Note:

- If the number of entries in Singles exceeds 24, then only 1 player per country will be accepted initially. Remaining places will be allocated based on 16 March 2026 PSA rankings.
 - 1 Wild Card reserved for the hosts, Japan.
- For Mixed Doubles, 1 pair per country will be accepted initially. The ASF Seeding Committee will determine the remaining places.
 - 1 Wild Card reserved for the hosts, Japan.

ENTRY FEES:

Single US150 /per person

Mix Doubles US250 /per pair

*Fees are to be paid after confirming how many players/teams are entered in each event.

CLOSING DATE:

16 March 2026

ACCOMMODATION:

No official accommodation will be arranged.

The recommended area to stay is around Nagoya Station, where there are many hotels.

From Nagoya Station, you can take the Aonami Line train to the venue. The ride takes about 24 minutes.

TRANSPORTATION:

No transportation is provided from the airport to the hotel or between the hotel and the venue.

However, there is a train from Chubu Centrair International Airport to Meitetsu Nagoya Station.

PLAYER ALLOWANCES:

We will reimburse transportation fees between Chubu Centrair International Airport and Meitetsu Nagoya Station, and between Nagoya Station and Kinjo-Futo Station (venue) for 4 days. In addition, we will provide a lunch allowance.

The total amount provided for the above will be **Yen 16,000 per player**. Payment will be made in cash (Japanese yen) on the first day of arrival to the team manager or coach. If neither is available, it will be paid directly to the player.

PRACTICE COURTS:

The official practice date is on **13 May 2026**.

We will inform you when and how to book the practice court once we confirm the draw.

PLAYERS WITHDRAWAL:

Withdrawal from the tournament must be notified to JSA as soon as possible by email.

Any withdrawal after payment, entry fees will not be refunded.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

In accordance with the Regulations of JSA and ASF

ANTI-DOPING:

All players must acknowledge and comply with the WSF's Anti-Doping Rules and Regulations, as well as the doping regulations outlined in Sections E12-E15 of the ASF Championship Regulations, as part of the accreditation process.

Any player who refuses to undergo doping control or is found guilty of a doping violation confirmed by a positive laboratory test will be subject to disciplinary action by the ASF in accordance with its established procedures and penalties.
